

HAVE YOU PAID YOUR 1996 DUES?

Chanco Lodge has a dues structure of \$6.00 per year when the dues are paid by December 1 for the following year. A one dollar (\$1.00) penalty fee will be charged after that date for late payment.

Non-payment of dues by December 1 places a member on the "provisional active role". Members on this role will receive mailings for one year. After that time, members on this role will be put in the inactive files and will receive no further information until dues are brought up to date. A member with dues more than one year behind must pay the current dues plus one (1) past year, or a total of \$13.00 to become an active member.

Check the label of this flyer. The upper right hand corner indicates your current dues status according to Lodge records.

REMINDER: To be a member of Chanco Lodge #483, a member must have paid his/her current years lodge dues and be properly registered in the Boy Scouts of America at the Colonial Virginia Council Office.
